TWTC & LOYOLA UNIVERSITY NEW ORLEANS POLICY:

As of February 1st for everyone age 5+, the City of New Orleans is requiring proof of two doses of the COVID vaccine, except for those who have received one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, or a negative PCR, molecular, or antigen test within 72 hours of the time of performance, (must include the individual's name, date of the test, and results clearly visible on an official report), to be admitted!

Masks are mandatory to be kept properly on the entire time.
